
## Special Areas of Conservation

Sample of plants, habitats, and animals within the Special Areas of Conservation found in Carlow:

Northern Atlantic wet heaths with Erica tetralix; European dry heaths; Transition mires and quaking bogs; Salicornia and other annuals colonising mud and sand; Water courses of plain to montane levels with the Ranunculion fluitantis and Callitricho-Batrachion vegetation; Hydrophilous tall herb fringe communities of plains and of the montane to alpine level; Old sessile oak woods with Ilex and Blechnum in the British Isles; Alluvial forests with Alnus glutinosa and Fraxinus excelsior (Alno-Padion, Alnion incanae, Salicion albae); Salmo salar (Salmon); Lutra lutra (Otter).
